More than 10,000 construction workers are injured from falls each year. Some common factors of Slips, Trips and Falls.

- Distracted workers
- Weather conditions
- Housekeeping
- Improper footwear

SLIPS

Slips happen where there is too little friction or traction between your footwear and the walking surface.

- Wet or oily surfaces
- Weather hazards
- Loose rugs or mats
- Walking surfaces with unequal traction



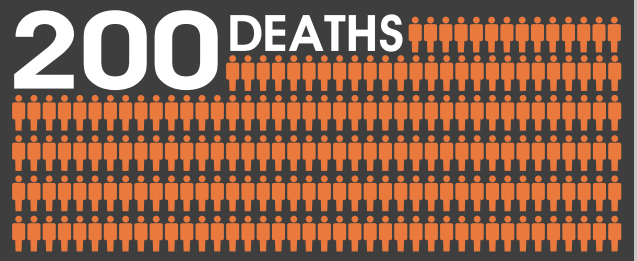
More than **8.7 million**

people are injured from slip, trip or fall accidents every year.

TRIPS

Trips occur when your foot collides with an object, causing you to lose balance and eventually fall.

- Obstructed view
- Poor lighting
- Clutter
- Uncovered cables
- Uneven walking surfaces



More than **200** construction workers are killed from slips, trips or falls in the United States.

FALLS

Falls from an elevation happen when workers are at risk of falling six feet or more.

- Ladders
- Roofs
- Down Stairs
- Jumping to a lower level

#1 goal is getting workers to be mindful of hazards. How to reduce the # of incidents:

- Develop an effective safety culture
- Train to address human factors
- Teach staff about safe footwear
- Maintain good housekeeping

Falls are the No.1 cause of deaths in the construction industry.
